The **Population Health Patient Management (PHPM)** MHSPHP application transforms Department of Defense (DOD) and purchased care administrative data into actionable information. TRICARE Prime/Plus enrollees in need of potential clinical preventive services, disease management or case management are identified on health care action lists. Using the PHPM application, all MTF and MCSC health care teams can proactively manage the health status of their patients over the web.

The **Population Health Dynamic Reports (PHDR)** allow a user to drill-through and customize measure-specific reports. Methodologies are based on Healthcare Effectiveness Data Information Set (HEDIS) methodologies or on DoD/VA Clinical Practice Guidelines. The National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) developed and maintains HEDIS.
