

## Identify the Right Mix of People for the Implementation Team

The right team is absolutely crucial for successful implementation of a clinical practice guideline. As you prepare for the satellite broadcast, consider who you need to include on your asthma guideline implementation team. A maximum of 8-10 members for your total team is suggested.

You will want:

A credible clinical champion to lead the team.

A facilitator or administrative champion who is experienced in group facilitation and who knows how to keep all team members involved in the process and will arrange meetings and other administrative support.

Someone familiar with your data systems.

Representatives of the people involved in the care of asthma patients: physicians, professional nursing personnel, and paraprofessional nursing personnel.

A leader from every location where you will be implementing the asthma guideline.
