

 **Air Reserve Components (UTA) - Allied Health**  Version 1.0  Providers requesting UTA privileges must also request privileges in their primary discipline.  Scope

 **P390811:** The scope of UTA privileges includes performing flying, non-flying and occupational medical examinations IAW AFI 48-123, Medical Examinations and Standards. Providers will order appropriate laboratory and diagnostic studies and refer to member's private health care provider for treatment and follow-up. Providers will take, evaluate and record comprehensive medical histories. Optometrists performs optometric exams, orders and administers medications for cyclopegic exams IAW AFI 48-123.

  Diagnosis and Management (D&M):

 **P390813:** Interpret clinical laboratory studies, X-rays, EKGs, pulmonary functions studies, optometric testing, and audiometric testing as limited by the provider's duty AFSC

 **P390815:** For the purpose of evaluation only, order appropriate laboratory and diagnostic studies and refer to member's private health care provider for treatment and follow-up

 **P390803:** Administer and/or supervise immunizations in accordance with AFIJ 48-110, Immunizations and Chemoprophylaxis

 **P390805:** Initiate consultation request to appropriate specialists for the purpose of evaluating fitness for military duty

 **P390807:** Prescribe pre-deployment medications in accordance with Air Force or Major Command (MAJCOM) policy
