

 **Air Reserve Components (UTA) - Nurse Practitioner**  Version 1.0  Providers requesting UTA privileges must also request privileges in their primary discipline.  Scope

 **P390809:** The scope of UTA privileges includes performing non-flying and occupational medical examinations IAW AFI 48-123, Medical Examinations and Standards. Nurse Practitioners will order appropriate laboratory and diagnostic studies and refer to member's private health care provider for treatment and follow-up. Providers will take, evaluate and record comprehensive medical histories.

  Diagnosis and Management (D&M):

 **P390801:** Interpret clinical laboratory studies, X-rays, EKGs, pulmonary functions studies as limited by the scope of practice for the provider's specialty

 **P390803:** Administer and/or supervise immunizations in accordance with AFIJ 48-110, Immunizations and Chemoprophylaxis

 **P390805:** Initiate consultation request to appropriate specialists for the purpose of evaluating fitness for military duty

 **P390807:** Prescribe pre-deployment medications in accordance with Air Force or Major Command (MAJCOM) policy
