 **P390688:** The scope of privileges in Developmental-Behavioral Pediatrics includes the evaluation, diagnosis, treatment and consultation for patients from birth to young adulthood concerning their physical, emotional, and social health as well as treating acute and chronic disease. Privileges also include providing care to patients who have complex medical problems or developmental disabilities, including coordinating multiple services and disciplines in an organized treatment plan, administration and interpretation of developmental testing, interpretation of psychoeducational testing and management of severe childhood behavioral problems, including the use of multiple psychotropic medication where indicated.

 **P390688-con't:** (scope of privileges in Developmental-Behavioral Pediatrics con't) Additional privileges include the initial evaluation of and genetic counseling for genetic conditions which are common in children with neurodevelopmental disabilities. Physicians may admit to the facility and may provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in accordance with medical staff policies. In addition, privileges also include the ability to assess, stabilize, and determine the disposition of patients with emergent conditions in accordance with medical staff policy.
