**C** **P387409:** The scope of privileges for a General Medical Officer (GMO) includes the assessment, evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of outpatients with uncomplicated and/or minor illnesses, diseases, injuries, and functional disorders. Physicians assess, stabilize, and determine disposition of patients in environments ranging from austere to fixed facilities in accordance with Service and MTF medical staff policies. The GMO will manage conditions consistent with training and will refer complex patients beyond the level of training to specialty medical care.
