

 **Neonatal Nurse Practitioner**  Version 1.0  Scope

 **P390481:** The scope of privileges for neonatal nurse practitioner includes the evaluation, diagnosis, treatment for term, preterm, and critically ill newborns and infants. Management of tertiary neonatal care to include ventilatory care, patients with neurological or postneurosurgical, postsurgical, or postcardiac/thoracic surgical organ dysfunction, prematurity, and/or who are in need of critical care for life-threatening disorders. Neonatal nurse practitioners may manage patients in the intensive care setting in accordance with medical staff policies.
