 Scope

P384381: The scope of privileges in ophthalmology includes the evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, consultation and performance of surgical and nonsurgical procedures on patients of all ages with ocular and visual disorders, including the eye and its component structures, the eyelids, the orbit, and the visual pathways. Physicians may admit and may provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in accordance with MTF policies. Privileges also include the ability to assess, stabilize, and determine the disposition of patients with emergent conditions in accordance with medical staff policy.

 Eyelid:

P384415: Lid and ocular adnexal surgery, including laceration repair, plastic procedures, reconstruction, grafting, chalazion, ptosis, repair of malposition, blepharospasm repair, tumors, flaps

 Conjunctiva:

P384417: Conjunctiva surgery, including laceration repair, grafts, flaps, tumors, lesions, pterygium, pinguecula, transplantation, lysis, cryotherapy and conjunctivoplasty

 Cornea:

P384419: Corneal surgery, including laceration repair, tumors, lesions, foreign bodies, grafts, flaps, diathermy, resection, and traumatic repair (including or excluding refractive surgery) but excluding keratoplasty and keratotomy

P384421: Epikeratophakia

P384423: Keratoplasty, penetrating, lamellar or endothelial

P384425: Intrastromal corneal rings

 Refractive surgery:

P384463: Incisional corneal refractive procedures (limbal relaxing incisions, arcuate keratotomy, astigmatic keratotomy)

P384465: Surface excimer laser corneal refractive procedures (photorefractive keratectomy [PRK] and laser epithelial keratomileusis [LASEK])

P384467: Intrastromal Excimer Laser Corneal Refractive Procedure (Laser-in-situ-keratomileusis, or LASIK)

P384469: Adjunct Chemotherapy for Refractive Surgery

 Lens:

P384457: All methods of lens and/or cataract removal through an anterior segment and posterior segment approach (intra- and extracapsular extraction, phacoemulsification), capsulotomy, capsulectomy

P384459: Pediatric (less than 6 years of age) cataract extraction and management

P384461: Intraocular lens insertion, repositioning, exchange or removal

 Iris:

P384455: Iris surgery, including laser or surgical peripheral iridotomy, iridectomy, tumor or lesion excision, biopsy, pupilo-/gonioplasty, repair of dialysis/defect, synechiolysis

 Glaucoma:

P384451: Primary surgical or laser trabeculectomy

P384453: Adjunct chemotherapy for glaucoma filtering surgery

 Sclera:

P384449: Scleral surgery, including repair of laceration or rupture, tumors, lesions, foreign bodies, grafts, flaps,

-  diathermy, cryopexy, dissection and resection and scleral implants and explants
-  Ocular muscles:
 -  **P384447:** Strabismus surgery
-  Orbit:
 -  **P384443:** Oculoplastic/orbit surgery, including FNA biopsy, exenteration, exploration by lateral orbitotomy, blowouts, rim repairs, excision of tumor or lesion, foreign body removal, and orbital volume augmentation
 -  **P384445:** Socket surgery, including grafting, repair of contracted socket, expansion to correct congenital deformities, augmentation for correction of enophthalmos, repair of extruding/extruded implant, and reconstruction
-  Lacrimal system:
 -  **P384441:** Nasolacrimal surgery, including biopsy, traumatic repair, excision of tumors, lesions, or lacrimal sac mass, dacryocystectomy, dacryocystorhinostomy, probing and irrigation, balloon dacryoplasty, ampuloplasty, fistula repair, and dacryoadenectomy
-  Retina:
 -  **P384437:** Retinal surgery, including biopsy, traumatic repair, aspiration, repair of macular hole, submacular dissection, retinotomy, relaxing incision, translocation, retinal detachment repair, membrane peeling
 -  **P384439:** Intraocular gas injection of the posterior segment and pneumatic retinopexy
-  Choroid:
 -  **P384435:** Choroid surgery, including biopsy, cryotherapy, diathermy, subretinal fluid drainage, and transpupillary thermotherapy of choroidal lesions
-  Vitreous:
 -  **P384429:** Posterior Vitrectomy, Pars Plana approach
 -  **P384433:** Anterior vitrectomy, limbal approach
-  Eyeball:
 -  **P384427:** Surgeries of the globe, including FNA biopsy, sub-Tenon's injection, removal of intraocular foreign bodies, repair of penetrating and perforating globe injury, evisceration or enucleation with or without implant
-  Anesthesia privileges
 -  **P387317:** Topical and local infiltration anesthesia
 -  **P387323:** Peripheral nerve block anesthesia
