 **P383291:** The scope of privileges in optometry includes the evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, and consultation for disorders, diseases, and injuries of the eye, associated structures and the visual system through a variety of tests and measurements. They identify systemic conditions affecting the eyes and vision and refer patients to patients to other providers as indicated. Optometrists provide pre and post operative assessments. Optometrists use topical diagnostic and therapeutic medications, fit and prescribe eyeglasses and contact lenses, and co-manage conditions that affect the ocular health and vision of their patients.
