

 **Pediatric Hematology/Oncology**  Version 1.0  Providers requesting privileges in this specialty must also request privileges in Pediatrics.  Scope

 **P390370:** The scope of privileges in Hematology-Oncology includes the evaluation, diagnosis, treatment and consultation for patients from birth to young adulthood presenting with diseases of the blood such as anemia, clotting disorders, sickle-cell disease, hemophilia, and cancers such as leukemia, lymphoma and other solid tumors. Physicians may admit to the facility and may provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in accordance with medical staff policies. In addition, privileges also include the ability to assess, stabilize, and determine the disposition of patients with emergent conditions in accordance with medical staff policy.
