

 **Pediatric Nephrology**  Version 1.0  Providers requesting privileges in this specialty must also request privileges in Pediatrics.  Scope

 **P390376:** The scope of privileges in nephrology includes the evaluation, diagnosis, treatment and consultation for patients from birth to young adulthood presenting with illnesses and disorders of the kidney, high blood pressure, and fluid and mineral balance. Nephrologist manage all types of dialysis treatments. Physicians may admit to the facility and may provide care to patients in the intensive care setting in accordance with medical staff policies. In addition, privileges also include the ability to assess, stabilize, and determine the disposition of patients with emergent conditions in accordance with medical staff policy.
