 **P389690:** The scope of privileges in Physical Therapy involves the evaluation and treatment of patients recovering from injury or disease. Physical therapy practitioners provide these patients with services that restore function, improve mobility, relieve pain, and prevent or limit permanent physical disabilities. Services include examination, evaluation, testing. Modalities may include measuring strength, range of motion, balance and coordination, posture, muscle performance, respiration and motor function, therapeutic exercises, strength and conditioning training, injury prevention and human performance optimization. Physical Therapists may see patients without a referral.
