 Scope

C **P385990:** The scope of privileges for women's health nurse practitioners includes the evaluation, diagnosis, treatment, disposition, and referral women of all ages with acute and chronic gynecologic and common non-gynecologic symptoms, illnesses, injuries, or conditions. WHNPs provide education on health, wellness, family planning, and the prevention and management of disease. WHNPs assess, stabilize, and determine disposition of patients with emergent conditions in accordance with medical staff policy.

 Diagnosis and Management (D&M):

C **P385992:** Routine prenatal care for low-risk pregnancies.

P385994: Uncomplicated postpartum patients.

C **P385996:** Treatment of male partners of patients with sexually transmitted diseases.

C **P385998:** Prescribe medications in accordance with Military Treatment Facility (MTF) Pharmacy and Therapeutics (P&T) policy

C **P386000:** Initiate temporary/limited duty profile in accordance with Service policy

C **P386002:** Place patients on quarters in accordance with Service policy

P385324: Therapy of condyloma and intraepithelial neoplasia
