IMPORTANT MESSAGE REGARDING CLINICAL DECISION SUPPORT TOOL ACCESS AND TRAINING

The MHS has recently contracted with McKesson to utilize their InterQual Anonymous Review tool. The tool provides:

- ❑ Acuity-based algorithms to support decision making at the point of care (MTF, ED, clinics), to include:
 - Appropriate level of care (right care, right time, right setting)
 - Length of stay
 - Discharge and transitions of care management
 - Right of First Refusal (ROFR) reviews
 - Medically necessary support for OHI reimbursement

Some of you have questioned why you are receiving emails from McKesson. The intent is to provide instructions on how to access the required Overview training, followed by another to access the tool if needed, to better manage your cases as noted above.
